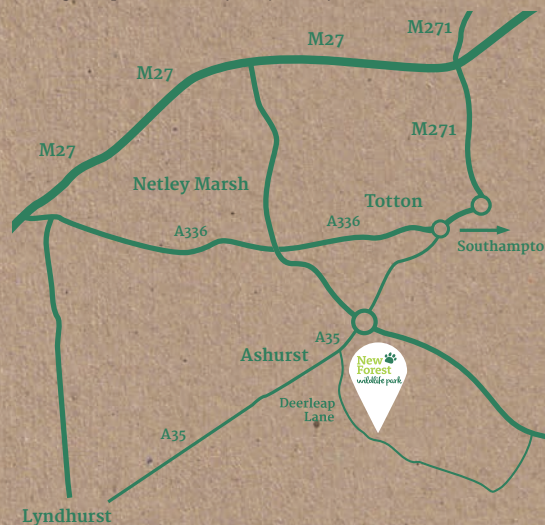


Coaches Welcome!

How to find us

We are situated off the A35 between Southampton and Lyndhurst. From the motorway system leave the M27 at Junction 3 onto M271 signposted Southampton and the Docks. Turn right at the end of the short M271 onto the A35 in the direction of Lyndhurst. Follow A35 for about 1.5 miles and look for brown tourist to New Forest Wildlife Park signs directing left into Deerleap Lane. From Lyndhurst follow A35 towards Southampton. After Ashurst village turn right into Deerleap Lane following brown tourist signs to New Forest Wildlife Park. We are 3/4 mile along Deerleap Lane on the left.

Sat Nav - Please put our address into your sat nav, as using the postcode only may take you on a less direct route.
